Although its one of the most important industries in the world, many people know very little about the Merchant Navy. Here at Warsash Maritime Academy we train people to become the navigation and engineering Officers who will sail these ships and bring our goods to us. British ship's officers have an excellent worldwide reputation and career prospects at sea or back on land are superb.

Salary and conditions of employment varies from company to company but an officer cadet will be paid by his or her sponsor during training and can expect to earn a very good salary when they qualify as a junior officer after 3 years.

Entry requirements are

4 GCSE's Grade A - C including Maths, English & Science for the HND programmes.

120 UCAS points in a Science or Maths based subject for our Foundation Degree programmes.

Sponsoring companies, lecturing staff and cadets currently in training will be able to talk about what life is like in the Merchant Navy and answer any queries you may have.
