LESSON 1	Introduction to Olympic Values	Teacher assessment of class work and understanding of the Olympic Values.	Students to research the Olympic Values and produce work which best represents the Olympic Values.
LESSON 2	Prior Purslove College talk	Students to self reflect and assess their future options and identify if Prior Purslove College is the right avenue for their future.	Students encouraged to attend as many college open days as possible. This will enable them to get some ideas of what field of work would most suit their interests.
LESSON 3-6	Good/Bad Citizenship- In depth look at the London Riots	Students to self assess their own contribution to society and determine which category (good/bad citizen) they fall into and why. Students will also look at a very current situation in the London Riots and the teacher will assess them on their Knowledge and understanding of the topic.	Students will know what a good citizen does and will hopefully reflect this outside of Laurence Jackson. Students will also be given the opportunity to research the London Riots in a considerable more detail in an out of school environment.
LESSON 7-10	Writing Personal statements.	Students will create a personal statement; this will be a formative piece which will be marked by the class teacher. The document will give potential colleges/employers the opportunity to gain an insight into the student.	Students can take this document home in order to improve it.
LESSON 11-14	Budgeting/Life after LJS	They will gain an insight into life post Laurence Jackson. Students will be marked on class work and what they produce within the lessons.	Students will learn how to survive after LJS. Therefore they will be required to use the content from the lesson and carry it out in every day society.
