<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Credits in year 10 will roll over into year 11 and can be used as money off the prom ticket or year trip to theme park. ▪ One credit is worth a 5p equivalent in rewards e.g. 160credits = £8 ▪ No cash prize is on offer unless stated above ▪ Any student achieving 200+ credits will also receive £10 voucher ▪ Y10 students must tally up their credits with their form tutors in preparation for Y11. 	

GLOSSARY OF REWARD TERMS

MERITS/CREDITS:

- These are stamps or stickers put in students planners along with staff signature/initials – Merits/credits add up to student prizes.

POSITIVE POSTCARDS:

- Positive postcards can be sent out by any member of staff to a student.

SPORT EXPECTATION SHEETS: (KS3 only)

- These will be used in form time as a means to monitor students in relation to SPORT expectations; if a student gets all ticks throughout a week – 1 merit/credit

STAR STUDENT AWARD:

- 'Star Student' – nominations are made prior to half term (see calendar dates)
- All members of staff can nominate their "star student" by completing a form in the staff room.
- All nominated "Star" students receive a certificate issued in assembly and letter is sent home.
- Certificates will include the staff's nomination quote about the student
- Any students who receive multiple nominations will receive a cinema voucher in addition to the certificate and letter home.
- "Star" students will take a seat on the "Stadium of Success" in the main school hall (certain seats have prizes attached to them; ipods/ cinema vouchers/high street vouchers).

ACHIEVEMENT ASSEMBLIES:

- A Celebration Assembly will take place at the end of each term e.g. Christmas, Easter and Summer
- Certificates and prizes will be issued per subject per year for 3 categories
 - Progress
 - Achievement
 - Subject "fair play" award
- DOL/HOD to issue positive postcards to all students nominated by the dept in recognition of their nomination.
- A Form tutor prize will also be issued during the celebration assembly based on the following
 - Form "Fair play" award
- All winners will be take a seat on "Stadium of Success."

THE STADIUM OF SUCCESS:

- Any student who is nominated for a "Star Student" award or who is issued with an award at the Achievement assemblies" will be placed in the "Stadium of Success" in the main school hall.
- The "Stadium of Success" will circle the school hall with photographs of successful individuals.
- At random "Seats" in the "Stadium" prizes will be issued. E.g. seat 32 will be covered by a picture of the 32nd prize winner in the year. Seat 32 will have a prize attached.
- Prize examples include: Ipod, vouchers, cinema tickets, etc. and will be issued during assemblies.
